



First Annual WFRCC Senior Pattern Association contest!

When? September 15, 2018.

Where? [Wichita Falls RC Airpark](#) located within Lake Wichita Park.

What? [Senior Pattern Association](#) Competition is based upon the “one maneuver per pass” aerobatic (pattern) competition flown in the 60s, 70s, and 80s. SPA legal airplanes were designed and flown prior to 12/31/1979. All SPA Classes and an Introductory class are offered with awards through 3rd place in each class. Contestant judging (per normal SPA practice). **All participants must be AMA members.**

This is our first attempt at this.....so we are keeping it simple, just lots of flying and camaraderie in a city park with excellent shelter, parking, and **lunch included** with **entry fee (\$25)**. The site is close to a large number of hotels/motels for those traveling a long distance and not wishing to make the contest a day trip.

Introductory class will not require SPA membership and is “fly what you got” with the exception of rotary wing aircraft and planes with engines over the SPA limit. Any typical sport plane or pattern plane is fine. IC engines less than 0.95 ci 4-stroke or 0.65 ci 2-stroke (no tuned pipes) and electric power less than 1400 watts are eligible. If you have retracts, you must fly with them extended.

Introductory class will fly the SPA “Novice” pattern. For any additional information about SPA visit the SPA website. [Maneuver descriptions](#) may be found on the SPA website.
